	Cardiff Council collects £181.8 million from Non-Domestic Rates (Business Rates) in Cardiff but only receives £107.2 million from the Welsh Government redistribution		
	This Council recognises Cardiff's role as capital of Wales and the economic driver for South Wales. As such we incur significant costs in hosting major conferences, sporting and cultural events. Sadly, unlike other capital cities within the UK, our city receives no specific revenue support to assist the fulfilment of this function.		
	We recognise the benefit to the capital city region in creating employment for people across the region, outside of the local authority boundaries, but note that we receive no specific assistance to support infrastructure to enable about 80 thousand people to commute daily into Cardiff to work We recognise the continuing congestion and need for investment in our roads and other infrastructure to keep the city moving, a need which will only be increased by the population growth assumed in the Local		

	Development Plan under guidance from the Welsh Government.		
	This Council therefore:		
	Instructs the Executive to lobby the Welsh Government and WLGA for a fundamental review of the specific allocation of Business Rates (Non-Domestic Rates) to the City and County of Cardiff. The Executive should forcibly point out that the loss of seventy five million pounds of Business Rates per annum creates much of the funding shortfall faced by the Cardiff City and County Council
