

Council calls upon the Cabinet to respond meaningfully to the clear message arising from consultation over budget proposals to remove the subsidy from 7 local libraries, as set out in line 32 of the budget proposals. Residents of Cardiff have attended consultations and organised protest marches and other protests; they have signed petitions in huge numbers. If consultation is to be taken seriously, this level of opposition to the proposed saving cannot be ignored.		
Accordingly, Council requests the Cabinet to find an alternative saving to replace in the plan year the saving of £283,000 which budget line 32 would have achieved. This will allow time and opportunity to devise a considered medium term strategy for the provision of library services.
