

Overview

LAMBY WAY - Capped Landfill Site capable of providing around 8.5MW of clean, renewable energy

- Equivalent to energy consumed by 2,600 average homes
- Offsetting approx. 1,600 tonnes of CO² emissions p/a
- Delivers on national and local targets for carbon reduction and energy security
- Attractive return on investment










June 2018 Cabinet Decision:

- Approved Outline Business Case...
 - Positive return on investment throughout
 - Enhanced by 20 year "Private wire" arrangement with Welsh Water



...and triggered next steps:

- to develop Full Business Case Detailed technical feasibility
- to prepare and submit a planning application;
- to finalise negotiations on the private wire offtake;
 - to commence procurement of a design and build contractor.



Detailed Technical Feasibility:

- Solar Electrical Engineers engaged
- Detailed layout developed, incl all known site constraints
 - Landfill cap protected
 - Landfill gas infrastructure protected
 - Ecology protected/enhanced
- Working performance model produced
- Detailed specification and performance guarantees for tender developed









Private Wire Negotiation

- MoU signed with Dwr Cymru/Welsh Water
- Detailed "Power Purchase Agreement" (PPA) developed and agreed
 - 20 year contract term index linked
 - Significant uplift to our sale of energy price compared to supply to grid
 - Significant Saving for DCWW
- PPA ready for signing following final Cabinet Decision
- Separate Civils Contract procurement to install private wire – 2 potential route options









Planning Application

- Submitted Feb 19
- Includes Reports on:
 - Design and access
 - Ecology (surveys and protection strategies)
 - Visual impact
 - Flood and drainage
 - ...etc.
- Decision 17th April Planning Committee



Typical "Ballasted" construction example No penetrative fixings allowed on the landfill cap








Ecology and Environment

- Reptiles, slow worms and protected species
 - Translocation before construction
 - Improved habitats to be include in development
- Birds
 - Strict development window to avoid nesting and overwintering seasons (heavy construction limited to July-Oct)
- Ecological management plan for lifetime of solar farm

 Completion of Wales Coastal Path and other public site access – facilitated through scheme's security fencing and CCTV
