Schools applied for

- 1. funding for training in ELSA
- 2. funding for training in LEGO: Build to Express
- 3. Wellbeing surveys and screening

Approximately

- 30% of schools applied for ELSA training and funding for a TA
- 25% of schools applied for Lego: Build to Express training and resources
- 7% of schools applied for Wellbeing surveys and screening

PDGLAC was used very successfully last financial year to support looked after children in Cardiff



- 2. This data helps us highlight the children who will need our support to ensure good education provision




Designated Teacher Training Days




One day per term. It has involved
