In accordance with Council Meeting Procedure Rule 22 (o) an amendment to the motion has been received proposed by Councillor Holden and seconded by Councillor Sanders.

In proposing and seconded this motion put following the Council Budget meeting 26 February 2015, concerns were raised there were serious issues arising from the setting of the Council's budget by the Leader and his Cabinet as well as significant concerns about the reputation damage to the city; confidence of investors and future plans for the city.

The Lord Mayor invited Councillor Holden to propose the amendment, which was to add the following words after Councillor Bale

'and the Leader is removed from office, with immediate effect'

The substantive motion would then read: -

'This Council has no confidence in the Leader, Councillor Phil Bale, and the Leader is removed from office, with immediate effect'

The amendment was seconded by Councillor Sanders.

In proposing and seconded the amendment it was stated that in addition to the damage to the reputation of the Council it was felt that there also had been a loss of respect in the leadership
