This Council notes the importance of Community Sports Clubs and the success of many of our local teams across the City and the vital role they play in community cohesion and in improving the Health and Wellbeing of the City. The Council further notes the importance Cardiff Council places on getting more girls into sport which includes Sports Cardiff's Girls Together event which will see 300 Primary School and 300 Secondary School girls take part in sporting events to mark International Women's Day in 2019.
