School Admission Arrangements 2019/20	In accordance with Section 89 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 and the Education (Determination of Admission Arrangements) (Wales) Regulations 2016 the Council is required to review the School Admission Policy annually. The School Admission Arrangements must be determined for implementation in September 2019. Prior to agreeing the aforementioned arrangements the Council is required to conduct annual consultation. On undertaking this process in 2016/17 stakeholders expressed that they wanted further consideration of additional/alternate criteria. As such Cabinet agreed to authorise officers to consider further the Council's school admission arrangements including wider research into alternative options and the impact of each, in advance of consultation on the Council's School Admissions Policy 2019/20. School Organisation Proposals: The provision of English- medium primary school places in the Adamsdown and Splott wards	At its meeting on 21 November 2016 the Cabinet agreed to authorise officers to: • seek the agreement of Welsh Ministers of the proposed modification to an agreed school organisation proposal to increase the capacity of Moorland Primary School from 2FE to 3FE from September 2017. • review projections and demand for English-medium primary school places in the area to inform the future progress of the proposed expansion of Moorland Primary School. Implementation of the proposal was subsequently deferred to September 2018. Pupil projections have now been updated and indicate that the predicted rise in pupil numbers has not materialised and that the proposed increased in provision at Moorland Primary School is no longer needed.
