#### 1. Application

1.1 An application for a variation to the existing Premises Licence, has been received from Mr Yi He in respect of Sun Sun Chinese Takeaway, 370 North Road, Heath, Cardiff, CF14 3BP.

1.2 The current Premises Licence permits the following:

Late night refreshment: Monday to Sunday 23:00 to 02:00

1.3 The following application for variation is now made:

To permit late night refreshment: Monday to Sunday 23:00 to 00:00

To permit the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises: Monday to Sunday 16:00 to 00:00

#### 2. Promotion of Licensing Objectives.

# Re APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A PREMISES LICENCE, "SUN SUN CHINESE TAKEAWAY" 370 NORTH ROAD, CARDIFF CF14 3BP.

I have caused enquiries to be made into this application and make the following representation that I wish to be considered when deciding on the licensable activity and conditions for this licence.

We therefore ask that the Licensing Committee hear the representation made by the Police when determining the grant of this application.

Should the applicants agree to comply with the representation made to meet the Licensing Objectives before a hearing then please accept that the Police will automatically withdraw their request for a hearing with the Licensing Committee.

### POLICE REPRESENTATION

- 1. The premises licence shall only remain in force as long as the main use of the premises is that of a facility offering food.
- 2. The sale of alcohol will be ancillary to the sale of a meal.
- 3. Alcohol will only be handed to the customer at the point that the meal is handed over.
- 4. A CCTV system shall be installed to a standard agreed with South Wales Police. It will be maintained and operated at all times the premises are open and alcohol is offered for sale. The system shall cover all areas to which the public have access (excluding toilets). Images shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days.

The images shall be produced to a Police employee or authorised Officer of Cardiff Council Licensing in a readily playable format immediately

upon request when the premises are open and at all other times as soon as reasonably practical. There will be sufficient staff training to facilitate the above.

5. Staff and delivery drivers will operate the challenge 25 policy in relation to alcohol sales.

If the applicant does not agree with the afore-mentioned representations the Police objections will be based on the following:-

The prevention of crime and disorder. The prevention of public nuisance. The protection of children from harm. Public safety.

(The omission of providing cctv images to the Police immediately upon request in the offered condition places a burden on the Police and the Crown Prosecution Service. Interviews of detained suspects will be unnecessarily delayed. Charging decisions from the CPS will also be delayed. This will have a negative effect on the four licensing objectives.)

Additional evidence to support the notice of the objection will be presented at any subsequent Licensing Committee hearing. This evidence will be expanded on verbally, written, statistical or CCTV evidence.

Extending the hours by which alcohol can be purchased in the vicinity, and when all other pubs & shops are closed, is not conducive to encouraging public order and could lead to public nuisance.
