1. Application

- 1.1 An application for the grant of a Premises Licence has been received from K and A Property Limited in respect of The Brass Beetle, 11-13 Whitchurch Road, Cardiff.
- 1.2 The applicant has applied for the following:

Supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises Monday to Sunday 11:00 to 15:00 and 17:00 to 23:00

2. Promotion of Licensing Objectives.

2.1 The additional conditions proposed by the applicant to meet the licensing objectives are attached to the report.

3. Relevant Representations

Representations have been received in respect of the application, copies of which are enclosed with the report.

The representation submitted by South Wales Police has been withdrawn as the applicant has agreed to the proposed conditions.

The representation submitted by Environmental Health (Noise Pollution) has been withdrawn as the applicant has agreed to the proposed condition.

4. <u>Legal Considerations.</u>

4.1 In respect of the application the decision must be taken following consideration of the representations received with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:

Prevention of crime and disorder Public Safety

Prevention of Public Nuisance Protection of Children from Harm

- 4.2 In each case the Sub-Committee may make the following determination
 - a) To grant the application.
 - b) To modify the conditions of the licence, by altering, omitting or adding to them, where relevant.
 - c) Reject the whole or part of the application.
- All decisions taken by the Sub-Committee must (a) be within the legal powers of the Council and its Committees; (b) comply with any procedural requirement imposed by law; (c) be undertaken in accordance with the procedural requirements imposed by the Council eg. standing orders and financial regulations; (d) be fully and properly informed; (e) be properly motivated; (f) be taken having regard to the Council's fiduciary duty to its taxpayers; and (g) be reasonable and proper in all the circumstances.

- 5.1 The application should be determined and the appropriateness of any conditions on the licence needs to be discussed.

I have caused enquiries to be made into this application and make the following representations that I wish to be considered when deciding on the licensable activities and conditions for the license.

I therefore ask that the Licensing Committee hear the representations made by the Police when determining the grant of this application.

Should the applicant agree to comply with the representations made to meet the licensing objectives before a hearing, then please accept that the Police will automatically withdraw their request for a hearing with the Licensing Committee

POLICE REPRESENTATIONS

I have identified conditions below which are appropriate and proportionate that would enable the premises to operate in line with the licensing objectives

NOT PROTECTIVELY MARKED OFFICIAL

- Premises licence only to remain valid as long as the primary function of the premises is that of a restaurant/café.
- 2. Seventy percent of licensable area where the public have access to be seated.
- 3. A CCTV system be installed to an agreed standard as approved by South Wales Police and maintained and operated at all times when the premises are open to the public.

The system will cover all internal areas of the premises where the public have access (excluding toilets), including all entrances and exits and any external area associated with the premises.

The images will be kept for a minimum period of 31 days.

A copy must be provided in a readily playable format to South Wales Police employees should it be requested within 24 hours of the request.

There will be sufficient trained staff to facilitate the above.

CCTV signage will be placed in prominent positions inside and outside the premises.

- 4. The premises will operate the 'Challenge 25 Policy. This policy will be brought to customers' attention through the display of appropriate signage. Challenge 25 notices will be displayed in prominent positions throughout the premises. The only form of identification recognised will be photographic identification cards, such as driving licence, passport or proof of age scheme (PASS) card.
- 5. All staff will be fully trained before they are authorised to sell alcohol and will be refresher trained on a regular basis, with records kept on the training, retraining and initial authorisation and re-authorisation.
- 6. No sales of alcohol are permitted in the rear outside courtyard.

Additional evidence to support the Police representations and conditions may be used at a subsequent hearing before the Licensing Committee; this may be expanded on verbally, or by way of written evidence.

Summary of my concerns about this application:

I have been living in the cul-de-sac end of Llanishen Street close to Whitchurch Road since 2002. This part of Llanishen Street provides a thoroughfare between Whitchurch Road and its surrounding area. Since the Licensing Act 2003 came into force in 2003, I have experienced numerous incidents of crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance in the proximity of my house. It is not unusual to find local youths and other people gathering around the benches and telephone box located between Llanishen Street and Whitchurch Road late at night in an intoxicated state.

I hereby strongly object any attempt to grant further licenses in the area. I note there are a good number of restaurants and supermarkets serving the area already.

Further details:

The application by Brass Beetle will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives. If the license is granted,

- (a) it will increase crime and disorder in the area. It is understood that an intoxicated person is more likely to become a victim of crime.
- (b) As stated in (a), an increase in crime and disorder will jeopardise public safety in the main thoroughfare in the area.
- (c) An intoxicated person(s) is likely to cause public nuisance in the area.
- (d) The area is a major thoroughfare between Allensbank Primary School and Whitchurch Road. The presence of intoxicated person(s) will no doubt affect the well-being of young children as well as youths and teenagers. This is in contrary to the objective for the protection of children from harm.
