1. Application

- 1.1 An application to vary a Premises Licence, has been received from Cornertrack Limited in respect of Miss Jones, 25-29 Merthyr Road, Whitchurch, Cardiff, CF14 1DA.
- 1.2 The Premises Licence currently permits the following:
 - 1. The supply of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises:

Sunday to Thursday: 09:00 to 23:30 Friday and Saturday: 09:00 to 00:30 New Years Eve: 09:00 to 04:00

2. The provision of regulated entertainment in the form of recorded music (indoors):

Sunday to Thursday: 09:00 to 23:00 Friday and Saturday: 09:00 to 00:30 New Years Eve: 09:00 to 04:00

- 3. The provision of regulated entertainment in the form of recorded music (outdoors): Monday to Sunday: 09:00 to 21:00
- 4. The provision of regulated entertainment in the form of live music (indoors): Sunday to Thursday: 09:00 to 23:00
- 5. The provision of late night refreshment (indoors and outdoors):

Sunday to Thursday: 23:00 to 00:00 Friday and Saturday: 23:00 to 01:00 New Years Eve: 23:00 to 04:00

1. 3 The following application for variation is now made:

To seek approval of alterations detailed in the plan submitted with the application. The alterations comprise of the following:

- 1. Removal of internal walls and relocation of bar servery
- 2. Staircase to first floor reconfigured
- 3. Refurbishment of external area and provision of new bar
- 4. New prep/storage area and toilet facilities on first floor
- 5. Creation of new roof terrace

4.1 The decision must be taken following consideration of the representations received with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:




- 4.2 In each case the Sub-Committee may make the following determination

- All decisions taken by the Sub-Committee must (a) be within the legal powers of the Council and its Committees; (b) comply with any procedural requirement imposed by law; (c) be undertaken in accordance with the procedural requirements imposed by the Council eg. standing orders and financial regulations; (d) be fully and properly informed; (e) be properly motivated; (f) be taken having regard to the Council's fiduciary duty to its taxpayers; and (g) be reasonable and proper in all the circumstances.


