## **Environmental Scrutiny Committee - 10 January 2017: Draft Cycling Strategy & Integrated Network Map**

Thank you for your comments and observations following consideration of the "Draft Cycling Strategy & Integrated Network Map" at Environmental Scrutiny Committee. I am able to advise as follows.

#### Comment

The figures provided in the presentation titled "Cardiff Cycling Strategy and Integrated Network Map" were all provided as percentage values and did not provide actual values, for example, cycling trips in the city centre increased by 86% between 2004 and 2014 – how many cycling trips does the 86% figure represent? I would be grateful if you could provide actual values for all of the percentage figures illustrated in the presentation.

### Response

Between 2004 and 2014:

- City centre traffic reduced by 30% from 149,100 to 103,900 vehicles per day
- City centre cycling increased by 86% from 3,010 to 5,610 per day
- Footfall at St David's Shopping Centre increased by 58% from 24 million to 38 million per year
