1. Application

1.1 A Temporary Event Notification was received on 10th November 2017 from:

1.2 The notification is in respect of an event which is to take place between 18:00 on 17th December 2017 and 01:30 on 18th December 2017 to allow:

- The sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises
- The provision of regulated entertainment
- The provision of late night refreshment

1.3 A copy of the objection is attached to the report and further evidence in support of the objection shall be produced at the hearing.

1.4 The Sub-Committee is required to determine if a Counter Notice, which would prevent the licensable activity from being authorised, should be issued.
