The applicant has requested a TEN be granted in respect of an event at the 183a Kings Road Yard in Canton, Cardiff.


The address contains a number of individual businesses with the applicant at the Lazy Leek which is a food outlet, the applicant requests a TEN to allow licensable activity in the form of the sale by retail of alcohol between 16:00 – 22:00 on the 21st July 2018. The maximum number of people being on site 200.

The activity will take place outside the lazy leek premises in a self-contained yard.

South Wales Police have made enquires and it has been established that there is no current Fire Risk Assessment in place for the area where this activity will take place.


As a result South Wales Police make an objection to the granting of the Temporary Event Notice on the grounds of Public Safety.
