1. Application

1.1 A Temporary Event Notification was received on 8th August 2018 from:

for authorisation of a temporary event at:

1.2 The notification is in respect of an event which is to take place between 25th August 2018 and 27th August 2018 between the hours of 13:00 and 02:30 each day. The TEN is proposed to allow the sale by retail of alcohol and the provision of regulated entertainment in respect of the Hub Festival.

1.3 An objection has been received from South Wales Police and a copy of the objection is attached.

1.4 The Sub-Committee is required to determine if a Counter Notice, which would prevent the licensable activity from being authorised, should be issued.
