This report identifies my key activities over the municipal year 2017/18 ending 24 May 2018. It is provided for the information of all constituents and for no other purpose.

**Section 1: Role & Responsibilities**

I was proud to be re-elected as a Liberal Democrat Councillor for Cyncoed and Lakeside, alongside my ward colleague Cllr Wendy Congreve. I am a member of the Corporate Parenting Committee. I am my party's Deputy Group Leader, and have shadowed the Cabinet Member for Children and Families.

**Section 2: Constituency Activity**

Over the last year I have handled more than 120 pieces of casework, covering a whole variety of issues including; waste collections and fly tipping, housing needs and maintenance, parks facilities and maintenance, outdoor maintenance of street furniture and trees, nuisance parking, anti-social behaviour, planning applications, social care, school admissions and pot holes.

I have worked tirelessly to ensure Cyncoed and Lakeside have safer roads and pavements. As a result a number of roads and pavements have either had temporary or long term work and some commitments were made with next financial year budget.

I have also held 19 surgeries at either Rhydepennau Library or Terra Nova Café.

**Initiatives and Special Activities**

I have submitting calls to call for safer roundabout, safer routes to Lakeside Primary and to Roath Park Lake. Currently we are calling for Clearwater Way Post-office service to be re-instated.

I am particularly proud of my council motion to address loneliness in Cardiff. The need to work across all sector to tackle loneliness, as it is seen to impact on individual's health and wellbeing.

I have been a School Governor at Lakeside Primary School since being elected in 2017.

**Other Activities/Issues**

I have organised and participated in regular litter picks with Keep Wales Tidy. I have regularly attended PACT meetings in Cyncoed and Lakeside.

I have attended community consultation event hosted by Christ Church, attended Lunch Club at Methodist church and also visited the Cyncoed Synagogue. I enjoyed attending the Allotment awards day event. I am an active member of Cardiff Met residents group.

I have also attended Muslim Council events and gender equality events. I was invited to launch a project to address women's health inequality.
