1. Application

- 1.1 An application for the Grant of a Premises Licence has been received from Lion Hills Ltd in respect of Lion Hills Ltd, 66 Plasmawr Road, Cardiff, CF5 3JX.
- 1.2 The applicant has applied for the following:
 - (1) In respect of the following licensable activities:
 - (i) The sale by retail of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
 - (2) Description of Premises (as stated by applicant):

"News and convenience store with post office, alcohol sale only to consume off the premises".

(3) Unless otherwise indicated the premises may be open to the public during the following hours and for any hours consequential to the non-standard timings:

Monday to Sunday: 06:00 to 00:00 hours

- (4) To provide licensable activities during the following hours:
 - (i) The sale by retail of alcohol for consumption off the premises:

Monday to Sunday: 06:00 to 00:00 hours

1.3 A site map showing the premises and the plan of the premises submitted with the application can be found in *Appendix A*.

2. <u>Promotion of Licensing Objectives</u>

2.1 The additional conditions proposed by the applicant to meet the licensing objectives are attached to the report and can be found in *Appendix B*.

3. <u>Relevant Representations</u>

- 3.1 A representation has been received from South Wales Police but following agreement the representation has been withdrawn. A copy of the representation and the subsequent agreement can be found in *Appendix C*.
- 3.2 Representations have been received from the other persons. Copies of the representations can be found in *Appendix D.*

4. Legal Considerations

4.1 In respect of the application the decision must be taken following consideration of the representations received with a view to promoting the licensing objectives, which are:

Prevention of crime and disorder Public Safety Prevention of Public Nuisance Protection of Children from Harm

- 4.2 In each case the Sub-Committee may make the following determination
 - a) To grant the application.
 - b) To modify the conditions of the licence, by altering, omitting or adding to them, where relevant.
 - c) Reject the whole or part of the application.
- 4.3 All decisions taken by the Sub-Committee must (a) be within the legal powers of the Council and its Committees; (b) comply with any procedural requirement imposed by law; (c) be undertaken in accordance with the procedural requirements imposed by the Council e.g. standing orders and financial regulations; (d) be fully and properly informed; (e) be properly motivated; (f) be taken having regard to the Council's fiduciary duty to its taxpayers; and (g) be reasonable and proper in all the circumstances.





POLICE REPRESENTATION

1. The hours permitted for the sale of alcohol shall be limited to 0700 to 2300 each day.

2. A cctv system shall be installed to a standard agreed with South Wales Police. The system shall be maintained and operated at all times the premises are open to the public. The system shall cover all parts of the areas to which the public have access (excluding toilets) and all entrances and exits including any outside area used by customers. Images shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days. The images shall be produced to a Police employee immediately upon request when the premises are open and at all other times as soon as is reasonably practical. There will be sufficient staff training to facilitate the above.

3. An incident and refusals log will be kept at the premises. This may be either electronic or written. The log will contain details of all incidents of disorder and breakdowns of the cctv system. The log will be made available for inspection by the police upon reasonable request.

4. An age verification system, such as Challenge 25, in relation ton the sale of alcohol.

If the applicant does not agree with the afore-mentioned representations the Police objections will be based on the following:-

The prevention of crime and disorder.

The protection of children from harm.

The prevention of public nuisance.

Additional evidence to support the notice of the representation will be presented at any subsequent Licensing Committee hearing. This evidence will be expanded on verbally, written, statistical or CCTV evidence.

This is to inform you that I will not be able to Chair the above application meeting as I will be stepping down as Chair for this item and opposing the application.

Fairwater News is a newsagent and post office in the same shopping parade that I have work in for over 50 years and to grant them a license to sell alcohol would in my view lead to more trouble than we are currently experiencing in the area.

First of all it's a busy shopping parade used by hundreds of school children in the morning and afternoon. There are already youths hanging around on a daily basis and the area if already suffering from drugs being sold openly on the streets and in front of the shops,

To grant an alcohol license will in my view cause not only a public nuisance but also place children in a harmful position.

I have witnessed children being approached by gangs to ask them to buy drugs and it's very intimidating as it is to go to use the shops after dark.

The granting of a license would lead to more friction and add to the crime and disorder that is happening around the area.

Not long ago we had an incident where a young man was set upon by the gangs hanging around that led to the hospitalisation of the victim for several months.

There is already alcohol for sale in the shop next door, adding more will not help or improve the area.

I have received complaints about the noise,gangs,drugs openly for sale at this location and I wish to object to the granting of another source of alcohol as it will lead to more crime and disorder,public nuisance and harm to children both living in the vicinity and going and coming from the schools nearby.
