The National Landlords' Association published figures in December, which showed that the number of private landlords letting to people on benefits has halved to just one in five. Could you outline the situation in Cardiff?</p>
16	<p><b><u>EDUCATION AND LIFELONG LEARNING QUESTION</u></b></p> <p><b><u>ORAL QUESTION FROM COUNTY COUNCILLOR BOWDEN</u></b></p> <p>The Council and Welsh Government rely on Governing Bodies to be leaders within their individual schools and certain training has now been made mandatory for Governors by Welsh Government. If Governors do not complete mandatory training within specified timescales, Governing Bodies have a duty to suspend them until they have done the training. Given that some of the training is currently not available from Governor Services, could you advise me on what Governing Bodies should do in these circumstances; and what the Council is proposing in terms of meeting the demands for mandatory training?</p>
17	<p><b><u>ENVIRONMENT QUESTION</u></b></p> <p><b><u>ORAL QUESTION FROM COUNTY COUNCILLOR GRAHAM THOMAS</u></b></p> <p>Dog fouling is a big problem in wards right across the City. I welcome the Council's crackdown and desire to do something about it. Please confirm how much was raised in fines for dog fouling in 2013 and with the new crackdown what the target is for 2014?</p> <p>How much will the new 24 hour response on cleaning up dog mess across Cardiff cost and is it realistic that fines will pay for the operation?</p>
