This objection is based on the exceptionally large amount of BMV (Best and Most Versatile land) threatened by the LDP proposals, approximately 320 hectares. The objection advises that the agricultural constraint, as required by Planning Policy Wales, should remain in place and be considerable weight to ensure the loss of BMV is minimalized and proceeds only after full consideration and justification of overriding need for development on BMV. As the Deposit version of the LDP is yet to be considered and tested by the LDP process and given that public opinion is overwhelmingly against development on greenfield sites, (NB Referendum poll results in Fairwater) how can it be justified to persist with plans to build on hundreds of acres of high quality food producing land?
