At the school where I am governor they have to scroll through 420 sheets for each year group to get the results for each child as there are 7 sheets for each child, one English for reading, then Welsh, then Maths procedure in English then Welsh then reasoning in English, then Welsh and finally an explanation sheet. It is extremely time consuming and the amount of printing necessary is very costly. There is no overview sheet for maths this year, one of the few aspects of the tests which was good last year, and no real explanation for parents on how the standardisation has been changed either.

As a result of this chaos, schools will have had to postpone until September the reporting of test results to parents. This is unacceptable in terms of school governance and so I would like to know what representations the Council is making to the Welsh Government in the light of this serious shortcoming.
