WORK PROGRAMME 2013/14 - UPDATE

Reason for the Report

To present an updated work programme to the Committee; to seek Members
agreement for a way forward for some of the items it contains; and to establish
membership of the Committee's chosen Task and Finish inquiry into Public
Engagement.

Background

- 2. The Council's Constitution states that each Scrutiny Committee will set its own work programme for the forthcoming year (Scrutiny Procedure Rule 7). The Committee is tasked with constructing a work programme for the year ahead that ensures the time available to the Committee is used most effectively by considering items in a timely fashion that maximise the impact of scrutiny. A measure of flexibility must be retained in order to accommodate additional or substitute other items as they develop.
- 3. This Committee agreed its 2013/14 work programme at its meeting on 12 September 2013. A copy of the work programme as agreed at that meeting is attached at **Appendix A**.

4. Members will find an updated draft Work Programme attached to this report at Appendix B. The Principal Scrutiny Officer will present the draft Work Programme at the meeting, highlighting any issues.

Way Forward

5. Members may like to consider and discuss the draft Work Programme, and decide whether they are content to approve it. Members also need to agree nominees to sit on the Committee's proposed Inquiry into Public Engagement in order to allow time for it to be scoped and planned in detail.

All decisions taken by or on behalf of the Council must (a) be within the legal powers of the Council; (b) comply with any procedural requirement imposed by law; (c) be within the powers of the body or person exercising powers of behalf of the Council; (d) be undertaken in accordance with the procedural requirements imposed by the Council e.g. Scrutiny Procedure Rules; (e) be fully and properly informed; (f) be properly motivated; (g) be taken having regard to the Council's fiduciary duty to its taxpayers; and (h) be reasonable and proper in all the circumstances.

As the recommendations in this report are to consider and review matters there are no direct financial implications at this stage in relation to any of the work programme.
