- Point of contact in the city centre
 - Partnership liaison
 - Customer facing
- Manage low-level interventions
 - Provide capacity for dealing with City Centre issues
 - Works in tandem with partners
- Provide active presence to manage the city centre
- NOT a replacement for other partners
- Daytime based

Day to Day Role

- Enforcement and public safety
 - Counterfeit Goods Seizure
 - Illegal MPV (Mechanically Propelled Vehicles) Seizure
 - ASB Referrals
- Community Engagement and Events – active involvement in:
 - Freshers' Week
 - Women's safety events
 - Varsity
 - Pride
 - PS events

Day to Day Role

- Community Engagement and Safety
 - Collaboration with SWP and Retailers
 - Body-Worn Video (BWV) Deployment
 - First Responders
 - Joint Patrols
- City Centre presence
 - Visible presence for city centre visitors and businesses
 - Supports delivery of policy and other Council activity, e.g. voluntary busking guidelines
 - The wardens have undergone comprehensive training, including SIA training, full first-aid training, and the use of defibrillators.

City Centre Management

- City Centre Manager plays a co-ordinating role amongst partners
