28 : APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE -
SNAILS,

Applicants: Robert Sykes represented by Bill Freeman

The Application

An application for variation of a Premises Licence was received from Rupert Sykes in respect of Snails, 6/8 Beulah Road, Rhiwbina, Cardiff.

The applicant applied to amend the licensable hours as follows:

1. To extend opening hours to 23:30 hours Monday to Sunday.
2. To extend the hours permitted for the sale of alcohol and to allow off sales as follows:

Monday to Sunday: 08:00 to 23:00
New Years Eve: 08:00 until the start of permitted hours on 1st January
- 3 To remove regulated entertainment from the licence.
- 4 To amend condition (3)to allow use of the external area until 21:00 hours.
- 5 To remove condition (2) which restricts alcohol sales to persons taking table meals.

The Sub Committee was advised that the applicant has agreed to accept the conditions suggested in the written representations received from South Wales Police and Pollution Control. The application would therefore be amended accordingly.

Mr Freeman presented the application and addressed the points raised in the representations received from the local ward Councillors. Mr Freeman considered that as the applicant by accepting the conditions suggested by South Wales Police and Pollution Control, each of the points raised by the local ward Councillors were addressed.
