	To aid compliance with this duty, the Environment Act requires Cardiff Council to prepare and publish a plan setting out how it proposes to comply with this new duty. This is referred to as the 'BRED Forward Plan'. Current guidance from Welsh Government is that this Forward Plan need not be a standalone document, but that it can be incorporated into other plans or strategies. Subsequently, during 2019 the Council is required to publish a report setting out what it has done to comply with this duty.

Street Naming Policy	A Street Naming Policy to provide advice and guidance to developers and existing property owners, setting out how the Council controls the naming and numbering of streets and properties under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1925 – Sections 17 to 19. In line with the Council's commitment to the Welsh Language Standards, there are important Welsh Language considerations in relation to new street names. The policy set out in the document is that for new street names, a Welsh name should be adopted which is "consistent with the local heritage and history of the area". This will also remove the need for English to Welsh translations for street names. The policy also sets out the corporate requirements around the Corporate Address Gazetteer, which is the primary address register used in the delivery of Council services.
