
## PART 7 - MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE

## **Cardiff Council Management Structure**

- 1. The Chief Executive (Head of Paid Service) is the most senior member of the Council's staff and has responsibility for overall management. He or she is supported by a small team of Corporate Directors who each take responsibility for a group of services and cross-cutting issues. Chief Officers (who report to the Chief Executive or a Corporate Director) each have operational responsibility for individual service areas, and are supported by a network of Operational Managers, who are responsible for day-to-day management of service provision.
