1. Application

- 1.1 An application to vary the Premises Licence has been received from SA Brain & Co Limited in respect of Three Arches, Heathwood Road, Cyncoed, Cardiff, CF14 4HS.
- 1.2 The application proposes to licence the external area and install a temporary bar as shown on submitted plan (drawing number LIC2).
- 1.3 The premises licence currently permits the following:

To provide licensable activities during the following hours:

- (i) The sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises:
 Monday to Sunday: 11:00 to 23:00 hours
 New Years Eve: 11:00 to the start of permitted hours on 1st January
- 1.3 Plan LIC can be found in *Appendix A*.

2. Promotion of Licensing Objectives.

2.1 The additional conditions proposed by the applicant to meet the licensing objectives are attached to the report and can be found in *Appendix B*.

3. Relevant Representations

- 3.1 A representation has been received from South Wales Police in respect of this application. A copy of the Police representation can be found in *Appendix C*.
- 3.2 A representation has been received from the Noise Pollution team in respect of this application. A copy of the representation can be found in *Appendix D*.

3.2 Representations have also been received from four 'other persons' as defined by the Licensing Act 2003. Copies of these representations can be found in *Appendix E*.

4. Legal Considerations.

4.1 In respect of the application the decision must be taken following consideration of the representations received with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:

- 4.2 In each case the Sub-Committee may make the following determination

- 4.3 All decisions taken by the Sub-Committee must (a) be within the legal powers of the Council and its Committees; (b) comply with any procedural requirement imposed by law; (c) be undertaken in accordance with the procedural requirements imposed by the Council e.g. standing orders and financial regulations; (d) be fully and properly informed; (e) be properly motivated; (f) be taken having regard to the Council's fiduciary duty to its taxpayers; and (g) be reasonable and proper in all the circumstances.

5. Issues for Discussion.

5.1 The application should be determined and the appropriateness of any conditions on the licence needs to be discussed.

ANNEXES: CONDITIONS

Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises

- (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises-
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
 - drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
 - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
- 2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 3. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
 - (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-
 - (a) a holographic mark, or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
- 4. The responsible person must ensure that-
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
 - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
 - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available."
- 5. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the

- 6. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1-
 - (a)"duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

 - (i)P is the permitted price,
 - (ii)D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii)V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
 - (c)"relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence-
 - (i)the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii)the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii)the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
 - (d)"relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and (e)"valued added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994
- 7. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 8. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
 - (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- (1) A CCTV system shall be installed to a standard agreed covering all areas that the public has access (excluding toilets) and including all entrances and exits. The system will be maintained and operated at all times the premises are open to the public. The system will facilitate the storage of images for a minimum of 31 days.
- (2) The external areas of the premises (intended for the consumption of alcohol and food) shall close by 23:30.



Re: Three Arches Public House, Heathwood Rd, Cardiff



The proposed variation from the existing licence will result in an unacceptable increase in noise and light levels for the following reasons:

- The purpose of this application is to attract more patrons and move more patrons to the outside area resulting in more noise and light.
- The extended seating area is open to the main road and residents directly opposite. There is no attempt in the proposed extension to reduce noise and light levels.
- The proposal includes operating the external bar until the pub closes i.e. the noise and light pollution will continue until midnight, which is long after local residents go to bed.

We believe this proposal will result in an increased risk of harm to children for the following reasons:

- The location of the external bar next to a children's playground is wholly inappropriate and would appear to promote a drinking culture to young children.
- The external seating area is not a safe enclosed area i.e. it gives direct
 access to Heathwood Road (a major arterial road). With parental drinking
 being promoted around the external bar and playground, it is to be
 expected that the parental supervision will be less than optimal with an
 increased risk of children accessing the road. An accident appears to be
 inevitable on such a busy road.

FURTHER COMMENTS

The proposal states that a temporary bar will be installed. This is contrary to the planning application where a permanent external bar is foreseen.


