#### 1. Application

- 1.1 An application for the grant of a Premises Licence has been received from McDonalds Restaurants Limited in respect of McDonalds Restaurants, Ty Glas Avenue, Llanishen, Cardiff, CF14 5DX.
- 1.2 The applicant has applied for the following:
  - (1) In respect of the following licensable activities:
    - (i) The provision of late night refreshment (indoors and outdoors)
  - (2) Description of Premises (as stated by applicant):
    - "The premises will operate as a restaurant selling food and non-alcoholic drinks for consumption on and off the premises"
  - (3) Unless otherwise indicated the premises may be open to the public during the following hours and for any hours consequential to the non standard timings:

Monday to Sunday: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

- (4) To provide licensable activities during the following hours:
  - a) The provision of late night refreshment (indoors and outdoors):

Monday to Sunday: 23:00 to 05:00 hours

- 1.3 A site plan of the premises can be found attached as **Appendix A**.
- 1.4 A location map showing the premises can be found attached as **Appendix B**.

#### 2. Promotion of Licensing Objectives.

2.1 The additional conditions proposed by the applicant to meet the licensing objectives are attached to the report and can be found in *Appendix C*.

#### 3. Relevant Representations

- 3.1 A representation has been received from South Wales Police in respect of this application. The conditions suggested by the Police have been agreed and the objection has therefore been withdrawn. A copy of the Police representation and the agreement can be found in *Appendix D*.

4.1 In respect of the application the decision must be taken following consideration of the representations received with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:







#### **Operating Schedule**

#### General

This restaurant understands that in extending our opening hours we have a duty to the local community and that we continue to protect our staff and customers from danger and harm. We believe that the systems we have in place are robust, thorough and will, as far as reasonably practicable, secure the promotion of the four licensing objectives. It should be noted that no McDonald's restaurant within the United Kingdom serves alcohol and further none of our drinks or food are served to customers in glass receptacles.

We are eager to work in partnership with all responsible authorities to ensure the promotion of the four licensing objectives. We also seek to work with the local communities, whom we serve, in achieving a successful cohesion between our business operations and our neighbours.

#### Prevention of Crime and Disorder

This restaurant is keen to work in partnership with the local police service to prevent crime and disorder.

#### CCTV

McDonald's operates a robust CCTV Policy to ensure compliance with Data Protection Legislation and to assist the Police with the prevention and detection of crime. At all stores where CCTV is in operation appropriate signage reflecting this information is displayed.

McDonald's operate digital motion activated CCTV systems where images are retained on a hard drive system. All CCTV equipment is of a standard suitable to record images of a proper quality, it meets the industry standard and has LGC Forensics or Kalagate Certification. As part of the digital system an alarm will sound if the equipment is faulty or not recording, thereby alerting management for the need to intervene. The CCTV system is regularly serviced by qualified maintenance technicians.

Access to the CCTV system will be provided to Police Officers at their request.

#### Staffsafe

A Staffsafe<sup>TM</sup> system with both audio and visual monitoring capability will be installed in the restaurant, this system, can be activated by either fixed or mobile panic buttons. Once activated the system links the restaurant to an external monitoring centre capable of intervening to resolve crime and disorder issues and/or provide the appropriate advice or instruction to support and protect the restaurant's staff and customers.

At this restaurant all shift managers have safety and security training; including Maybo SIA accredited Conflict Management Training.

#### Public Safety

This restaurant is keen to work in partnership with the local Fire Service and Environmental Health Officer to ensure public safety.

This restaurant has safety systems in place to protect the safety of customers and staff at all times (such as Staffsafe). We work with the local Environmental Health Office and local Fire Service to ensure we are complying, as far as reasonably practicable, with relevant Health and Safety and Fire Safety Legislation. This restaurant is also subject to inspections from our own safety and security teams to ensure our systems are being maintained.

All of our restaurant staff receive comprehensive safety training to ensure that safe working methods are adopted and all staff are trained on the restaurant's evacuation procedure in the event of a fire or other dangerous occurrence.

This store operates a "No Open Alcohol Containers" policy to prevent persons carrying open alcohol into the in-store area.

#### Public Nuisance

#### Litter

McDonald's were the first company in our sector to introduce litter patrols in the early 1980's. McDonald's is committed to carry out litter patrols collecting both McDonald's packaging and any other litter that has been carelessly discarded. We are happy to act on recommendations from the Environmental Health Officer should they feel that we should extend our patrol to a nearby area, as far as this is reasonably practicable.

All of McDonald's packaging displays the "Bin It" symbol to encourage our customers to deal with their waste responsibly. Further details regarding McDonald's commitment to reducing waste and litter nuisance can be found at the "Our World" section of the McDonald's website: http://www.mcdonalds.co.uk/ourworld/environment/policy.shtml

#### Noise

Where it is practical to do so we are content to put measures in place to limit noise. All McDonald's restaurant doors are self-closing and we try to encourage our customers to be considerate to our neighbours and to limit noise both when ordering their food and on leaving the local area.

#### The Protection of Children from Harm

McDonald's do not anticipate that unaccompanied children will use the restaurant in the extended hour's period covered by this licensing application. We do however take their safety extremely seriously and will continue to employ the same practices to ensure that they are protected from harm at all times when visiting the restaurant.

#### Re APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE

I have caused enquiries to be made into this application and make the following representation that I wish to be considered when deciding on the licensable activity and conditions for this licence.

We therefore ask that the Licensing Committee hear the representations made by the Police when determining the grant of this application.

Should the applicants agree to the representations made to meet the Licensing Objectives before a hearing is held then please accept that the Police will automatically withdraw their request for such a hearing with the Licensing Committee.

#### **POLICE REPRESENTATION**

1. A CCTV system shall be installed to a standard as approved by South Wales Police and maintained and operated at all times the premises are open to the public. The system will cover all internal areas of the premises where the public have access {excluding toilets} including all entrances and exits and any external areas associated with the premises. The images shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days and shall be produced to a Police employee in a readily playable format immediately upon request when the premises are open and at all other times as soon as reasonably practicable. There will be sufficient trained staff to facilitate the above.

- 2. Members of the public shall not be permitted to consume food and drink or remain in any outside area under the control of McDonalds between the hours of 2300 and 0730 each day.
- 3. Security Industry Authority (SIA) Door Supervisors will be employed at the premises following the completion of a written risk assessment undertaken by local senior management team or in consultation with the police. Such a written assessment will be kept for a period not less than 12 months and produced to a police employee upon request.
- 4. An incident book will be kept and maintained at the premises at all times. It shall be made available on request to a Police employee. This book will record the following:

All crimes reported at the venue

Any ejections of patrons

Any disorder on the premises

Any visit by representatives of a relevant authority or emergency service Any failure of the CCTV system.

- 5. When SIA registered door supervisors are employed at the premises they will utilise at least one body worn video device. Any such device will be capable of recording both audio recordings and visual images. The recordings will be kept for a minimum of 31 days and will be produced to a Police employee in a readily available format immediately upon request when the premises are open and at all other times as soon as reasonably practicable. There will be sufficient trained staff to facilitate the above.
- 6. A register of door supervisors shall be kept at the premises. The Register shall show the full name and SIA registration number of each door supervisor, stating the start and end duty times from each door supervisor. The Register shall be kept by the DPS for a minimum of 12 months and will be made available to a Police employee on request.
- 7. Persons under the age of 16 years must not be permitted to enter or remain on the premises after 23:00 hours unless accompanied by a person over the age of 21 years. A notice to this effect must be prominently displayed at the entrance/exit to the premises.
- 8. The Premises Management must ensure that any WIFI System used at the premises can be switched off at times to prevent or defuse any anti-social behaviour or at the request of Police.

- 9. The premise management must engage with the Neighbourhood Policing Team on a regular basis.
- 10. The footpath immediately outside the premises must be kept clear of litter emanating from the premises.
- 11. Training records must be kept to record staff training and advice in relation to conflict management. All such books/records must be retained at the premises for at least 12 months and must be made available for inspection and copying by a Police employee, immediately upon request.
- 12. The area immediately outside the premises including any external seating area and street/pavement surrounding the premises will be patrolled by management staff or SIA door supervisors after 23:00pm until close everyday at least every hour to ensure that persons do not congregate in that area and to avoid any noise or other nuisance or disturbance being caused to neighbouring residents and businesses.
- 13. Notices will be prominently positioned at all exits of the premises reminding customers to be respectful to nearby residents and neighbouring premises, to avoid causing noise, nuisance or disturbance and not to loiter outside the premise when they leave.

If the applicant does not agree with the afore-mentioned representations the Police objections will be based on the following:-

The prevention of crime and disorder.

The protection of children from harm.

(These conditions are present on other similar licences in Cardiff and have proven that they are reasonable and necessary to promote the licensing objectives.)

Additional evidence to support the notice of the objection will be presented at any subsequent Licensing Committee hearing. This evidence will be expanded on verbally, written, statistical or CCTV evidence.

To whom it may concern,

In accordance with the Health Board's role as a responsible authority I can confirm we have received the following application for a premises license for: McDonald's Restaurants, Ty Glas Avenue, Cardiff for the provision of late night refreshment (indoors and outdoors): Monday to Sunday: 23:00 to 05:00.

I understand that this application is for McDonalds and would enable the restaurant to operate 24 hours a day selling food and non-alcoholic drinks for consumption on and off the premises.

The Health Board objects to this application under the licensing objective 'Prevention of Public Nuisance'.

24 hour operation of this premises in a residential area is considered to be unacceptable due to the potential impact upon local residents in terms of public nuisance through the time period this application covers.

Directly across the road from this premises is a residential development providing 49 retirement apartments for the over 70s. Some of these apartments have balconies which look out towards the restaurant. The residents of these properties are likely to suffer disturbance from noise, odours and light pollution, particularly late at night.

There is a significant amount of evidence about the negative impact on health of sleep disturbance, and nocturnal noise pollution in particular can significantly impair sleep. Sleep disturbance for people living near the restaurant from noise generated by people visiting the restaurant, traffic from visitors, the drive-thru and the delivery service and noise from air conditioning units and extraction units could all be a factor. Light pollution could also cause sleep disturbance.

The World Health Organisation (2018) states that the health impacts of environmental noise at all times of the day and night include cardiovascular disease, sleep disturbance, cognitive impairment and mental health and well-being. Nocturnal noise pollution causing sleep disruption can have substantial adverse short and long-term health consequences. Short-term can include increased stress levels, mood disorders, reduced quality of life and memory deficits. Long-term consequences can include high blood pressure, cardiovascular disease, cancer and weight-related issues.

There are late night opening premises located within a 5 minute walk of the restaurant, which serve alcohol, and could result in intoxicated customers from these premises congregating at the restaurant late at night, creating public nuisance. As a Health Board we would be concerned that the late opening of this premises could contribute to a rise in anti-social behaviour in the area which would disturb local residents.

The grounds for my opposition are based on the following requirements of the Licensing Act 2003:

- 1. Due to the location of the Church Inn Public House in relation to the new McDonald's restaurant, Kimberley Terrace will be the main thoroughfare for the pub patrons to walk to the restaurant. This is entirely predictable due to the trend of drinkers seeking 'junk food' after the pub has shut. This will encourage additional numbers of people passing down the street and will increase the already antisocial noise and public nuisance that exists when the pub closes.
- Due to the above increased numbers of pedestrians using Kimberley Terrace at closing time, it is entirely
  feasible that more incidents of damage to vehicles and property will occur, through either malicious

- 1. There is a real risk that this licensing application will result in crime and disorder issues. We already see many cars in the area travelling fast, driving illegally late at night on Ty Glas Industrial Estate. The presence of a 24 hour McDonalds in a residential area will only serve to attact late night activity of this sort. The application applies to both indoor and outdoor 24 hour licensing. This creates a 24 hour meeting place/haven in a residential area this is well away from arterial roads similar to other similar sites in Cardiff and may allow an area of drug use/selling to develop
- 2. Public Nuisance One of the criteria discussed by councillors at the planning meeting was that a drive through would stop the constant ingress/egress of people into the restaurant late night car doors closing etc. This application is for both indoor and outdoor 24 hours usage so it seems those arguments were false. It was clear that the vast majority of local residents who expressed an opinion on the development were against it, even amongst those that were positive, many of those voiced concerns on the 24 hour opening hours. There is an elderly residential property directly opposite the site the constant traffic and late night activity will undoubtably cause nuisance to some of the most vunerable people in our community.

# Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives The risk of harm to children has supposedly been addressed despite the huge amount of opposition by the local Coed Glas primary school (less than 100m from the site), health professionals and residents. In any case, the granting of 24 hours at this site will only serve to compound the original decision as these children progress into adulthood with the increased risks of fast food outlets on child obesity. As has been discussed at length, England has legislation that would have stopped this site being granted permission. Wales, as the UK's most obese nation at school age, sadly does not. A 24 hour license would only serve to set a precedent for pending applications for other fast food outlet applications that we have heard are coming in the near future.



I would like to submit my comment in relation to the above application. I'm a resident living in close vicinity to the newly acquired McDonald's site. As local police are well-aware every year we already have significant issues with people using the industrial estate (and the roads immediately off Ty Glas Road) as a late night race track, with cars doing speeds that look to be in excess of 60mph and using the roads to practice handbrake turns etc. We also have issues with various groups using that immediate area to deal drugs and set off fireworks (all year round). My concerns about McDonald's opening overnight are two-fold: Firstly that this will attract more people to visit during antisocial hours using McDonalds as a base to then possibly engage in such illegal activities as described above; and secondly that people visiting purely to use the restaurant and leave during the late night opening hours are potentially at risk of driving in the area for the reasons outlined above. Several pedestrians have had near misses during the last year where the cars racing have actually mounted the kerbs and in one case literally drove over a cul de sac green space to get onto another road.

I also have concerns with regard to increasing litter, which is already an issue. I'd suggest people will be more likely to litter under the cover of darkness.

#### Please summarise your concerns about this application

I am a Cardiff resident living directly opposite the McDonald's restaurant. My apartment is in a block of 36 apartments for people aged 60 and over. Also on the site, only metres across the road from McDonald's, is a block of 49 apartments offering extra support for people aged 70 and over. Cardiff Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2016 - 2021 states on page 21: When making a decision the authority will focus on the direct impact of the activities taking place on the licensed premises on members of the public living, working or engaged in normal activity in the area concerned. My concerns are that the applicant has completely disregarded the direct impact of its activities on the people living in these 85 apartments, as well as the other residents living in the immediate neighbourhood. This is in contravention of the requirement for applicants to have regard to their proximity to residential properties (page 35 of Cardiff Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2016 - 2021). When McDonald's application for a drive thru was being considered by Cardiff Council's Planning Committee, it was stated that, if approved, this location would be the closest drive thru to residential properties anywhere in Cardiff. This must be a consideration in determining whether it is appropriate to grant a licence for the provision of late night refreshment (indoors and outdoors), with all its adverse effects on the licensing objectives.

# Please give further details of <u>why</u> you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives

#### Prevention of crime and disorder

Evidence from other locations shows that having a venue that is open between 23.00 and 05.00 results in opportunities for groups of young people / adults, including those who have been drinking / taking controlled substances, to gather. This can then result in confrontation and fights.

It also provides an opportunity for people to use and buy/sell drugs.

In other locations police have reported that 24-hour McDonald's restaurants have attracted crime and anti-social behaviour.

There are no other locations in this residential area where late night refreshment is available. Therefore, in addition to local people, others will travel into the area during the early hours of the morning. As part of their marketing strategy for 24-hour opening, McDonald's has created a 'restaurant finder' smartphone application to enable people to find their nearest open restaurant at any time of day or night. McDonald's are therefore actively encouraging people to travel distances to get to these 24 hour locations. As a result, there will be more traffic and people in this location throughout the night, increasing the risk of crime and disorder. A residential neighbourhood in this section of Ty Glas Avenue is not an appropriate location for this type of 24-hour business.

There is clear evidence that when groups congregate under the influence of drink and/or drugs, crime will increase. Additional police resources will be required in these circumstances.

#### **Public safety**

Ty Glas Avenue is a busy road and the additional traffic which will inevitably occur if McDonald's is open during the night will increase the danger to road users. The layout of the road outside the McDonald's entry/exit and the entry/exit to llex Close already presents hazards.

There is evidence for a causal link between the presence of a McDonald's restaurant/drive thru and increased litter in the vicinity.

This is because many customers discard their containers etc on the pavements and roads and not in the bins on the McDonald's site. This situation is worse when customers are under the influence of drink/drugs. This will attract rats and seagulls, which are already a problem in the locality.

#### Prevention of public nuisance

Cars entering and leaving the McDonald's premises during the night, car doors being opened and closed, people entering/leaving their cars and walking to the restaurant will all create noise and public nuisance for the residents at unsociable hours. During the hot summer nights this will be an even worse problem when bedroom windows are left open overnight. This will have a significant adverse impact on elderly and vulnerable residents, some of whom will be trying to sleep in their beds less than 30 metres away.

There will be significant light pollution for the residents of Llys Faith and Llys Isan if this licence is granted. Bright lighting has already been installed on the external site by McDonald's and it is not appropriate for this to stay on all night when residents are just across the road. My apartment directly overlooks McDonald's and the light impact is significant. The proximity of the McDonald's restaurant to Llys Isan is shown in photo 1 (McDonald's on left of road, Llys Isan on right). Photo 2 shows the view from one of the Llys Isan apartment balconies facing Ty Glas Avenue. McDonald's is very close.

The residents of Llys Isan fronting Ty Glas Avenue will be directly impacted by the headlights of moving cars as they travel in a northerly direction on the east side of the building to park. It will also happen when cars drive in an easterly direction on the north side of the building to exit the drive thru facility.

There will also be bright lights in the restaurant overnight. As Llys Isan is a 4 storey building and Llys Faith is a part 4 storey / part 3 storey building, this light pollution will not be mitigated by the 900 mm headlight barrier along the northern perimeter of the site fronting Ty Glas Avenue.

In addition, there is no headlight barrier to protect the Llys Isan apartments which are directly opposite the exit route for traffic from McDonald's. Photo 3 is taken from the junction of this road with Ty Glas Avenue and shows the extent of the impact that the headlights will have on the Llys Isan apartments.

The increased traffic and footfall explained in the crime and disorder objective above are relevant for this section as well.

There is also a very real risk of displacement of unsociable behaviour / criminal activities to our development. The bright lighting on the McDonald's site could encourage their late night customers to cross the road and use darker areas of our development to use/buy/sell drugs or cause damage to property and cars, thus

causing a public nuisance. Children and young people already wander into our development and I have personally observed one instance of two adults under the influence of controlled substances ('spice') directly outside our development.

Cardiff Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2016 - 2021 states on page 9: Applicants should consider the benefits of exceeding their statutory consultation requirements by proactively seeking the views of local residents, local ward councillors, businesses and responsible authorities on their operating schedules. It is extremely disappointing that McDonald's have not made any attempt to engage with or seek the views of the residents of Llys Faith and Llys Isan.

#### Protection of children from harm

In their application McDonald's state in their Operating Schedule that they do not anticipate that unaccompanied children will use the restaurant in the extended hours period covered by this licensing application.

The Licensing Act 2003 defines children as those under the age of 16 years. There are many children of this age in the locality and they frequent the skateboard park 150 metres away from McDonald's regularly. They are often out on their own, on foot and on bikes, and come into our development on Ilex Close, even though it is a private road. There are no gates at the entrance. Children in their mid teens are often seen late at night in the area and if McDonald's is open after 23.00 that will act as a magnet for them.

They would be susceptible to being targeted and recruited by unscrupulous drugs gangs during this period.

Making fast food available between the hours of 23.00 and 05.00 encourages children to have a poor diet and this will have long term health consequences for them.

Children walking to nearby schools during the day would be seeing discarded litter in the vicinity, creating a very poor example for them.


In conclusion, for the reasons I have outlined in this representation, I believe that this licence application should be refused altogether.

#### Dear Sir / Madame

I would like to object to the application for late opening of the McDonald's restaurant located at Ty Glas avenue.

This will create a public nuisance to adjacent residents, local residents and the surrounding borough of Llanishen encouraging unprecedented through night activity and the development of an unmanageded night time economy.

Llanishen no longer has any police presence in the vicinity. Residents being physically attacked by visitors to the area have had to wait for the police to be called more than three times before any officers are deployed to attend to the incident. Encouraging visitors to the area throughout the night while it is unamanaged by any police presence will have a negative effect on local crime incidences. This eventuality can be demonstrated by recent police submissions to the licensing department objecting to other late opening licenses and requesting onerous security presence conditions to manage what is otherwise an unmanaged night time economy.

Being the only 24 hr venue of its kind in the area the granting of this licence will have an inevitable promotional marketing effect on the surrounding area. Marketing of fast food is known to be causative of childhood obesity. Childhood obesity is now the greatest harm affecting the Welsh population. Granting of the application is thereby known to cause harm to children.

This venue is located very close to a school and a local leisure centre and playing field. The late opening licence will result in children being affected by the fast food marketing and availability not only during their school years but also after school during teenage years.

The application will thereby cause further harm to children in their teenage years who are still classed as children and should be protected from harm.

Public nuisance caused to elderly residents in the adjacent specialist older persons accommodation is excessive particularly given many such residents are very frail and will likely suffer from respiratory illnesses. The older persons within our society should be able to sleep undisturbed by excessive frying and idling car fumes.

Any attempt to argue that public nuisance will be greater if the licence is not granted is incoherent and is here refuted as unreasonable and evidenced by the volume of adjacent residents objecting to this application. This application will increase public nuisance. It is irrational or erroneous to suggest otherwise.

Attracting cars to drive through Llanishen village through the night will obviously create disturbance and public nuisance.

Littering can rightly be considered a public nuisance. Provision of bins has never before stopped the littering that has become synonymous with these venues.

Public disorder and littering in nearby parks.

Granting this licence risks nearby car parks becoming late night hangouts which are unmanaged by any police or other presence and thus become a littering and anti social behaviour hotspot.





This application has caused a lot of consternation amongst residents of our ward, many of whom have expressed their dismay to us in person at PACT meetings, residents' groups and at our advice surgeries. We believe the application will lead to an increase in crime and disorder, an increase in public nuisance and fails to protect children from harm.

# Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives

#### Prevention of crime and disorder:

Having spoken with the local Police team, we are concerned that the presence of a 24hr McDonald's will lead to an increase of crime and disorder in the area. In the words of one PCSO, "We always see a spike in antisocial behaviour around other McDonald's in the city". We see no reason why that should not also be the case here. The Police have enough resources in the city centre to deal with problems arising from 24hr fast food restaurants. Here in Llanishen there is virtually no night-time economy and therefore inadequate Police resources to respond to incidents. Branches of McDonald's in the city centre need to employ door staff to ensure the safety of patrons at night. Will this be the case here?

#### Prevention of public nuisance:

Directly opposite the site is a new residential home providing assisted living for the over-70s. Many of these people have complex and chronic medical needs. These are likely to be exacerbated by the increase in noise, lighting, litter, traffic and general disturbance emanating from a 24hr fast food establishment. We have already dealt with casework relating to strongly-illuminated late night signage from businesses in Ty Glas Business Park disturbing the sleep of vulnerable residents of the new home. We submit that this is the closest McDonald's to a residential development in the whole of Cardiff and, as such, is wholly unsuitable for 24hr opening.

#### Protection of children from harm:

Quoting directly from Cardiff Council's Report to the Cabinet meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> Nov 2019, Agenda Item 3: Cardiff Food Strategy:

"The UK is in the grip of an obesity crisis. It's estimated that 1 in 4 UK adults and 1 in 5 children aged 10-11 are obese (source: NHS). These figures are higher in more deprived areas. Obesity leads to a number of serious and potentially life threatening conditions such as type 2 diabetes, coronary heart disease, some types of cancer, stroke plus psychological problems such as depression and low self esteem. Poor diet is the main cause of obesity along with lack of exercise. Those in deprived areas are less likely to be able to easily access or afford good food.

"In addition, similarly to many UK urban areas, Cardiff also has an abundance of fast food outlets many of which serve unhealthy options. Research undertaken in 2018 (source: FXTM) gives Cardiff the questionable title of being the 'Fast Food Capital' of the UK, having more outlets per head of population than any other UK city. Overall Cardiff has 30.50 fast food franchises for every 100,000 population which is more than any other UK city, and in comparison more than London (9.39) and Edinburgh (23.91)."

This McDonald's is situated within sight of Coed Glas Primary School (whose Headteacher and pupils protested against its very opening, on the grounds that fast food contravenes the School's healthy eating policy), on the edge of one of the more economically disadvantaged housing estates in the area. According to the above quoted sections, the presence of this establishment is directly likely to cause harm to children.

This is further evidenced by the recommendation made in the Cardiff Food Strategy, Section 4, Part B: Planning restrictions on fast food outlets:

"Action: To produce a planning note around fast food planning restrictions – considering saturation limits for areas and exclusion zones around schools.

To explore the opportunities to use the planning system to control the location of fast food outlets across the city."

Cardiff Council, therefore, recognises the harm caused to children by locating fast food outlets close to schools. Approving this application would be in direct contradiction to the parts of Council's own Strategy outlined above.

Whilst we recognise that the building in which McDonald's is situated already has planning approval for A3 use, this application is to extend the opening hours. We contend that it is entirely within the remit of this Licensing Sub-Committee to give weight to the factors stated above and refuse this application.
