

## PART 7 – MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE

### Cardiff Council Management Structure

1. The Chief Executive (Head of Paid Service) is the most senior member of the Council's staff and has responsibility for overall management. He or she is supported by a small team of Corporate Directors who each take responsibility for a group of services and cross-cutting issues. Chief Officers (who report to the Chief Executive or a Corporate Director) each have operational responsibility for individual service areas, and are supported by a network of Operational Managers, who are responsible for day-to-day management of service provision.

As changes in responsibilities may be made from time to time to improve service delivery, the details are not included in this Constitution.
