**1. Application**

1.1 A Temporary Event Notification was received on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2021 from:

Jade Steer

for authorisation of a temporary event at:

Bootlegger  
Unit 4, The Grand  
Westgate Street  
Cardiff, CF10 1BR

1.2 The notification is in respect of an event which is to take place from 18:00 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 to 04:00 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to allow the sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises and the provision of regulated entertainment.

The notice giver has given the following information with regards to the nature of the event:

*“We regularly host live music events as allowed by our current licence on Thursdays and Saturdays, we would therefore like to have an extended licence until 4am for New Year’s Eve to continue selling alcohol for consumption on the premises. There will be a rock & roll band playing until 2am latest and a DJ playing until 4am”.*

1.3 An objection has been received from South Wales Police and a copy of the objection is attached.

1.4 The Sub-Committee is required to determine if a Counter Notice, which would prevent the licensable activity from being authorised, should be issued.
