However, in order for this to happen there must be buses available for residents to use. In Old St Mellons bus routes have been cut, with Cardiff Bus routes 30 and 45 scaled back, including at peak times and in evenings. As a consequence, buses are not a viable alternative for many residents. What plans do the Council have to improve bus provision for residents and organisations in Old St Mellons and surrounding areas?</p>

Some locals spoke about the "nauseating stench" and the fact "huge rats" have been seen "having the time of their lives" amongst the flytipped broken bin bags. It was reported the pile of refuse became so big that it completely blocked the nearby pavement on Drawlings Close in Old St Mellons, forcing passers by with both prams and wheelchairs to walk into the road to get around it. Does the Cabinet Member agree with me that instead of pursuing large vanity projects, such as the Cardiff Indoor Arena (partly funded through millions of pounds in borrowing), this Council should instead focus on the bread and butter issues residents face, like ensuring their rubbish is collected frequently and on time?</p>
