All crews are being asked to narrow return the pavements. receptacles to frontages where possible, and when on terraced streets, to return as close to the wall of property as possible to reduce pavement obstructions. Supervisors are tasked with monitoring collection crews on a daily basis to ensure this instruction is being adhered to. As above, training will be provided to collection crews pre-roll out, and will also be included in upcoming Team Briefs to remind crews of the need to be sensitive when returning containers, and to do so in such a way as to not block the highway.
